



#### CRS Aid for the Earthquake in China

Catholic Relief Services (CRS) is bringing aid in the aftermath of the earthquake that hit the Sichuan region of China this weekend. We are responding through the Caritas network and local partners and have committed an initial \$50,000 to relief efforts. The 6.6-magnitude quake killed at least 188 people and injured more than 11,500. It struck a mountainous area of western China, where the terrain has hampered relief efforts. Local partners report they are in the quake-hit area, but are struggling to reach Taiping, a remote township in the epicenter. The most urgent needs are food, medicine and clean water according to initial assessments. Pope Francis said on Sunday, "My thoughts also go to those who were affected by the earthquake that struck an area south-west of mainland China. We pray for the victims and for those who are suffering because of the violent earthquake."
